



CALL FOR APPLICATIONS – ERASMUS+ MOBILITY TO FRANCE

Program overview:

As part of the Erasmus+ Mobility Program for students and higher education staff funded by external policy funds (AC171-HED), the Royal University of Law and Economics (RULE), in cooperation with Lumière Lyon 2 University, is launching a call for applications for a study stay in France **lasting 2 to 6 months**. This opportunity is open to PhD candidates in Law or Economics, wishing to deepen their knowledge within the stimulating academic environment of Lumière Lyon 2 University.

Number of available positions :

- 2 positions for Law and/or Economics and Management

Each mobility must last at least 2 months.

Mobility period: Between September 2026 and July 2027. (The mobility must end before 31st July 2027!)

The application file must include:

- Research proposal and research themes
- Motivation letter (in French or English)
- Curriculum Vitae (CV)
- Copy of passport and/or ID card
- Enrollment certificate (or equivalent) confirming registration at home university
- Proposed scientific program during mobility period
- Letter of recommendation (optional)
- Annex 1 – AMO Form (for candidates applying for inclusion support)

Evaluation criteria :

- Academic/scientific background (30%)
- Quality of personal and professional project (30%)
- Assessment of the candidate's motivation during the interview with the selection committee (30%)
- Language proficiency (French or English) (10%)

Selection committee composition :

- Representative from relevant faculty of RULE
- Representative from relevant faculty of Lumière Lyon 2 University
- Representative from the International Relations Office of Lumière Lyon 2 University

Application procedure:

Selection process and timeline :

- 1) Call for application: March 30 – April 30, 2026
- 2) Application deadline : May 1, 2026
- 3) Evaluation of applications: until May 8, 2026
- 4) Pre-selection of applications – ranking of candidates: May 15, 2026
- 5) Interviews with the highest-ranked candidates: May 18 – May 22, 2026
- 6) Results announcement: May 26, 2026*



* *Appeal against the decision: Candidates have a period of seven (7) working days, starting from the date of publication of the results, to submit an appeal.*

Financial conditions:

As part of this project, selected students will receive an **Erasmus+ KA171 scholarship** amounting to **€900 per full month, up to a maximum duration of 6 months**, for a maximum total of **€5,400**.


An additional lump-sum grant of **€1,735** is provided to cover **travel expenses** between Cambodia and France.

The scholarship will be paid according to the following schedule:

- **70% upon arrival in France,**
- **30% at the end of the stay,** subject to the **submission of the required supporting documents** (certificate of attendance, mobility report, etc.).

Accommodation :


No accommodation is provided by Lumière Lyon 2 University. Selected students must arrange their own housing. However, they will receive support from the International Student Office, like all incoming international students.

 It is strongly recommended to check in advance the cost of housing in Lyon, which can be high, as well as the overall cost of daily living.

An International Student Guide, containing all practical information to facilitate arrival and settlement, will be provided by Lumière Lyon 2 University. An information session will also be organized by the International Relations Office.

Inclusion support :




Students **with fewer opportunities** may receive an **additional €250 per full month** (Erasmus+ individual support), subject to meeting one or more of the defined eligibility criteria.

 See the criteria below.

Applicants wishing to request this support must **complete the dedicated form** (Annex 1 – AMO Form) and include it in their application file.

At the end of the selection process, pre-selected candidates will be required to submit the necessary supporting documents to their International Relations Office, which will verify their eligibility for this support.

Eligible Inclusion Criteria, applicable to each partner of the Erasmus+ KA171 project:

Criteria		Required documents
Specific medical condition (recognized disability, chronic illness, diagnosed learning difficulties, etc.)		Medical certificate
Financial hardship (low family or individual income)		Certificate of reduced university tuition fees, proof of receiving a scholarship based on social criteria, or any document conforming to government regulations.
Social barriers (ethnic minorities, migrants or refugees, single parents, first-generation higher education students, individuals who have lived or are living in institutional care, etc.)		Family record book, asylum application or visa issued in the country of the home institution, certificate from the home institution

Individuals with limited access to education due to geographic isolation in rural areas	☑	Proof of residence, certificate from home institution in accordance with government regulations
