



CALL FOR APPLICATIONS FOR ERASMUS+ MOBILITY IN FRANCE

Program overview:

As part of the Erasmus+ Student and Staff Mobility in Higher Education program supported by external policy funds (AC171-HED), the Royal University of Law and Economic Sciences, in cooperation with Université Lumière Lyon 2, is launching a call for applications for a 6-month study placement in France, open to undergraduate students in Law and/or Economic Sciences who wish to deepen their knowledge within the stimulating academic environment of Université Lumière Lyon 2.

Although this mobility does not lead to the award of a degree from Université Lumière Lyon 2, it offers students the opportunity to complement their training in Law and/or Economic Sciences and to gain international experience.

Available spots:

- 4 undergraduate or Master's level spots in the Law track
- 2 undergraduate level spots in the Economics and Management track

Each mobility period has a maximum duration of 6 months.

Planned mobility dates: September 2026 – February 2027 or January 2027 – July 2027 (depending on the chosen semester)

The application file must include:

- Transcripts for the current academic year and the previous year, where applicable
- A motivation letter in French or English
- A Curriculum Vitae
- A copy of the passport and/or identity document
- An enrollment certificate (or equivalent) confirming registration at the home university
- A pre-selection of desired courses
- A recommendation letter (Optional)
- **Annex 1 – AMO Form**, to be provided by applicants requesting an inclusion supplement

Evaluation criteria:

- Academic prerequisites (30%)
- Quality of the personal and professional project (30%)
- Assessment of the candidate's motivation during the interview with the selection panel (30%)
- Proficiency in the required language (French or English) (10%)

Selection panel composition:

- Representative from each relevant department at URDSE
- Representative from each relevant department at ULL2
- Representative from the International Relations Office of ULL2

Selection procedure and timeline:

1. Publication of the Call for Applications: March 30, 2026 to April 30, 2026



2. Application submission deadline: May 1, 2026
3. Application review: until May 8, 2026
4. Application selection – candidate ranking: May 15, 2026
5. Interviews with the highest-ranked candidates: May 18 to May 22, 2026
6. Publication of results: May 26, 2026*
7. Start of mobility: September 2026 or January 2027

*Appeals against the decision: candidates have a period of seven (7) working days, starting from the date of publication of the results, to lodge an appeal.

Financial conditions:

As part of this project, selected students will receive an **Erasmus+ KA171 grant of €900 per full month, capped at 6 months**, for a maximum total of **€5,400**.

An additional flat-rate travel allowance of **€1,735** is provided to cover **travel costs** between Cambodia and France.

The grant will be disbursed as follows:

- **70% upon arrival in France**,
- **30% at the end of the stay**, subject to the **submission of required supporting documents** (attendance certificate, mobility report, etc.).

Housing conditions:

No accommodation is provided by Université Lumière Lyon 2. Selected students will need to arrange their own housing independently. They will receive support from the International Students Office on the same basis as all incoming international students.

⚠ It is strongly recommended to research in advance the cost of housing in Lyon, which can be high, as well as the cost of daily living.

An international student guide, containing all practical information to facilitate arrival and settling in, will be provided by Université Lumière Lyon 2. An information session will also be organized by the International Relations Office.

Inclusion support:

Students with **fewer opportunities** may be eligible for an **additional amount of €250 per full month** (Erasmus+ individual support), subject to meeting one or more of the **defined eligibility criteria**.

Applicants wishing to request this support must complete the **dedicated form** (Annex 1 – AMO Form) and include it in their application file. Following the selection process, pre-selected candidates will be required to submit the necessary supporting documents to their international relations office, which will verify their eligibility for this support.
